EXPECTED TAX AUDITS

We have learnt that the Tax Authorities and Social Insurance Fund are looking to intensify their respective audit programs and start inspections of taxpayers in the coming weeks.

Audits are expected to be fairly aggressive and raise some of the historical tax issues. In light of this development, it is highly advisable that taxpayers conduct pre-audit reviews of their tax compliance in order to collate necessary documentation and resolve any outstanding issues.

PwC has developed a special "health-check" program designed to review and identify areas of potential non-compliance and tax leakages.
